## 2021 WAGE <u>INCREASE</u>

EFFECTIVE, JANUARY 1, 2021

The Area II Inside Electrical JATC Committee collected a wage survey from all registered training agents. The wage was calculated by adding all the reported average hourly wages and dividing the total by the number of participating training agents.

The annual wage for 2021 <u>increased</u> to <u>\$37.59</u> per hour for an average Area II Inside Electrical journey worker. See below for the wage breakdown for Area II Inside Electrical apprentices. The effective date is <u>January 1, 2021</u>. (Last year's wage was \$36.11)
